

## Drostdy Hof Steen 2001

### Export Only

This is a young wine as fresh and delicate with fruity aromas on the nose. On the palate it is well balanced with a crisp and lingering finish.

**variety :** Chenin Blanc | Chenin Blanc (Steen)

**winery :** Drostdy-Hof Wines

**wine of origin :** Coastal

**analysis :** alc : 12.73 % vol    rs : 3.7 g/l    pH : 3.45    ta : 6.1 g/l

**type :** White

**pack :** Bottle

**in the vineyard :** The Chenin Blanc/Steen grapes for this wine came from vineyards in the Perdeberg/Wellington areas planted at 130 to 180 metres above sea level. The vines were planted between 1970 and 1988.

**about the harvest:** The grapes were picked by hand at 21°Balling.

**in the cellar :** In the cellar the juice was briefly in contact with the skins before it fermented at 14°C for 14 days.
