Deep plums, smokey, scrub, silky mouth-feel with a bit of milled pepper. Good fruit-acid tension and grip in finish.

This wine will compliment roasts and casserole dishes of lamb and beef as well as game dishes.

in the vineyard : The grapes come from the Paarl region, a sub-region within the greater Coastal region.

in the cellar : Aged in first fill barrels for 8-12 months.
