

Grande Provence Cabernet Sauvignon 2011

A full bodied red wine with upfront red berry aromas on the nose. Ripe berry fruit, plum and delicate white pepper follow through onto the palate. A touch of mint is noticeable on the finish. Smooth with velvety tannins, well integrated oak and an elegant finish.

Versatile food wine and compliments poultry and red meat dishes, especially roasts, marinated steaks and lamb skewers with mushroom and rosemary.

ageing : Enjoy now or cellar for 3-5 years.

in the vineyard : The well drained, decomposed sandstone soils are ideal for the cultivation of Cabernet Sauvignon. The winemaker also ensures special canopy management which resulted in berries with deep color and concentrated fruit flavors.

about the harvest: The Grapes are harvested from south-westerly facing vineyards in the Franschhoek valley.

in the cellar : Wine was oak matured for 15 months.
