

La Capra Pinot Grigio 2013

Pale green colour in the glass with flinty and floral notes on the nose combined with pear drop. A delicate palate with lingering zesty acidity and granny smith apple, finishing off with a refreshing, clean after taste making this wine easy drinking for any occasion.

in the vineyard : These grapes are sourced from dryland vineyards in the Swartland.

about the harvest: The grapes were hand harvested at 20° Balling.

in the cellar : Gently crushed and separated from the skins. After 48 hours settling, the clean juice was cold fermented in a stainless steel tanks, only free run juice was used. The wine spent 3 months on fine lees before it was stabilized and bottled.
