

## Leopards Leap Shiraz 2014

**WINE STYLE:** Medium-bodied, typical Rhône style characteristics. **NOSE:** Deep purple layers of plum and blackberry, intertwined with subtle undertones of cracked black pepper. Whiffs of clove and coriander create a rich and intense aroma on the nose. **PALATE:** Complex and well-rounded with an elegant tannin structure that culminates in a lingering aftertaste.

This wine is the perfect partner to roasted game, herb-infused lamb, fillet steak and grilled vegetables.

**in the vineyard :** Grapes come from Swartland and Perdeberg in Agter-Paarl.

**about the harvest:** Grapes were picked at 24.5° Balling.

**in the cellar :** Grapes were sorted, destemmed and crushed. Fermentation took place with selective yeast accompanied by pump-overs and punch-downs at 28°C. 50% of the wine was matured in 225-litre French oak barrels for a period of 12 months. The balance of the wine was oak staved for 6 months with added micro-oxygenation.
