

## Gold Coast Big Red 2012

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Dark magenta-garnet; young, sweet, bubble gum, perfumed, rose and a "fruit bomb" of red cherries, raspberries and rich blackberry nuances with hints of cola, vanilla, mint, cedar and sweet oak. On the palate sweet, cherry cake and crème brulee, soft tannins; good balance and a long finish

The wine shows plenty of Merlot's personality, flavor appeal and an invitation for a generous piece of dry matured rib eye steak.
