in the vineyard : The Chenin Blanc is from our first crop from our Casey's Ridge Kogelberg vineyard in Elgin. The grapes all came in at very low yields due to wind damage in early summer.

in the cellar : The wines were fermented in 225 litre French oak barrels using 2nd and 3rd fill barrels. The Viognier adds more elegance and fruit to the blend. Orange-peel and citrus on the nose...
