

Simonsig Adelberg Sauvignon Blanc 2014

Fruity, dry white wine made in the classic Bordeaux style. Youthful green tinged straw colour. Concentrated tropical and green fig flavours dominate the nose. The palate is welcomed with a variety of tropical flavours, together with perfectly balanced acidity and chalky aftertaste, making this wine a complex fresh and crisp Sauvignon Blanc.

This wine pairs very well with a variety of salads i.e. Caprese salad and seafood salad. Also excellent with sushi, mussels done in a creamy white wine sauce and lemon and herb spiced chicken.
