in the vineyard : The 2013/2014 growing season will be remembered as one of the wettest seasons, which had two effects on the 2014 harvest. One, it resulted in a bigger crop, especially in Sauvignon Blanc, and two, it brought fungal disease to some varieties. It was a huge challenge for the viticulturist to keep the vineyards healthy and in pristine condition. During the last part of the harvest, continuous rain showers, especially in March, put a strain on the ripening of the Cabernet Sauvignon. Although the 2014 harvest had its unique challenges, it delivered wines with great quality.
