Deep, concentrated, ripe, almost sweet cherries and sprig of mint carry through to opulent, silk-textured palate, all echo with cedary oak..

in the cellar : The grapes are all from the Kleine Zalze Farm where the 30 year old vines produce excellent grapes yielding an average of 4 t/ha. The grapes were picked at 22 Å°B, then fermented with selected dry yeast. After fermentation, extended skin contact was given. After pressing, the Cabernet went straight to small French oak for 13 months prior to bottling.
