This light Sauvignon Blanc is a fresh, crisp wine. On the nose, tropical flavors of peach, guava, pineapple and ripe passion fruit. Medium bodied with a bright acidity adding freshness with an aftertaste which makes you long for the next sip.

The wine can be drunk on its own as an aperitif or with white meats and pastas, tomato based dishes and light salads.

The components were fermented separately in stainless steel at cold temperatures (11-13 degrees Celsius). Regular lees stirring occurred to add richness, the end result of which is a wonderfully aromatic wine with great body and a lingering aftertaste, true to Sauvignon Blanc character, perfect for everyday drinking.
