

## Backsberg Shiraz 2013

Red berry aromas are interlaced with subtle notes of tobacco and vanilla, derived from maturation in French oak barrels. The palate is rich, spicy and complex, displaying layers of fruit and oak tannins with a soft velvet finish.

Compliments spicy cuisine, cured meats and braaivleis.
