about the harvest: The grapes are from selected vineyards in the Tulbagh Valley. Both machine and hand harvested at 21° Balling.

in the cellar : This wine is fermented with selected yeasts to enhance the natural flavours of the chosen cultivars. By blending different cultivars and adding grape concentrate a nicely balanced light-bodied semi-sweet wine is produced.
