

Hoopenburg The Guru Sauvignon Blanc 2016

Nose: Notes of guava, green fig leaf and litchi. Palate: A refreshing, fragrant summer wine with a satisfying finish

variety : Sauvignon Blanc | 100% Sauvignon Blanc

winery : Hoopenburg Wines

in the vineyard : The grapes for this wine are sourced only from the coolest slopes in the Western Cape, enabling only the best Sauvignon grape flavours to be released into the wine.

about the harvest: The grapes were harvested by hand earlier this year into small 20kg cases. The grapes were then transported in the cool of the morning to the Hoopenburg cellar.

in the cellar : Here they were hand tipped into the press for a long three hour whole bunch pressing session. After this the juice was cold fermented for 3 weeks in stainless steel tanks. Once dry the wine was racked off its fermentation lees and aged for 6 months before being bottled.
