

Kaapzicht Kaleidoscope White 2016

A soft, well rounded balanced white blend of Roussanne, Verdelho, Chenin Blanc, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon. Floral aromas driven by the Roussanne and Sauvignon, along with ripe yellow stone fruit and apple. Although more rich and complex than the other whites in the range, the 2016 Kaleidoscope White is still a versatile fresh and juicy white, in a light frame, and with crisp acidity.
