Vineyards are carefully monitored by the winemaker who ultimately decides when the grapes will be harvested. These grapes are handled separately in the cellar to preserve their natural quality and uniqueness.

Darling Cellars Premium is a dedicated concept from site selection, through to the final drop in the glass at the end of a bottle.

in the vineyard :

Terroir: Deep dark coloured soils from decomposed Granite in the Darling Hills. Micro climate positively influenced by the Atlantic with sunny days and cool evenings
Vineyard type: Bush Vine, no irrigation

about the harvest:

Yield: 4-6 t/ha

Balling at Harvest: 26-27°B

in the cellar :

Vinification: Whole berry fermented for 5-7 days on staves at 20-30°C

Maturation: Aged for 22 months French oak barrels
