Full bodied multi-cloned blend of noble varietals. Intriguing aromas of cassis and tea leaf are followed by hints of dark chocolate and cigar box. A tightly-packed wine with a long lingering finish.

about the harvest: Balling at picking: Cabernet Sauvignon: 26.2°B | Merlot: 25°B | Cabernet Frand: 24.9°B | Petit Verdot: 24.9°B

in the cellar : These grapes received 6 days cold maceration prior to fermentation in stainless steel tanks. Fermented at between 24° - 28° C for 1½ weeks. The wine was then moved into 225 litre barrels, 45% new French oak 225 litre barrels for 14 months maturation.
