

## Spotswood Durif 2012

This unique wine varietal is a robust red wine and a recent cultivar for South Africa, although grown in France, California and Australia (sometimes referred as a Petite Sirah). The nose and flavour are unique with mocca, dark chocolate and tobacco notes, and the colour is intensely dark purple. It is well-balanced and multi-layered yet easy-drinking and succulent.
