about the harvest:

The berries ripened in different stages during the time of harvest.

in the cellar :

The cultivars fermented separately in different stainless steel tanks. After gentle-pressing malolactic was encouraged in the finest 225 lt French oak barrels where it matured for 18 months. 30% new French oak 30% 2nd fill French oak and 40% 3rd fill.
