

- Darling Cellars Old Bush Vines Chenin Blanc: This wine displays a medium light straw hue in the glass with a green tinge and is made in a ripe tropical style with a split personality being elegant on the one hand but serious and bold on the other. Tropical flavours of ripe yellow peaches, white pear, a touch of vanilla blossoms, toast, butterscotch, orange skin and pineapple meet you on the nose. This wine shows many layers as the Chenin Blanc opens up
- Stellenrust Chenin Blanc: This Chenin Blanc shows strong lime and some tropical fruit on the nose with a mineral palate of grape fruit and pear drop.
- Villiera Chenin Blanc: The wine has abundant fruit with a hint of wood spice
 on the nose, including pineapple, guava and citrus. On the palate it is rich with
 a hint of freshness. It is well balanced with a long finish.
- Hoopenburg Chenin Blanc: Prominent guava aromas are supported by flavors of litchi and mango, with a subtle herbaceous undertone.
- Durbanville Hills Collectors Reserve Cape Garden Chenin Blanc: Rich, well-integrated wood with predominantly citrus drive profile, lingering orange rind and pear flavours with tantalising stone fruit on the aftertaste.
