in the cellar : This is a natural semi-sweet wine. The grapes are picked later in the season with a higher sugar content. The fermentation is stopped at the desired sugar using cooling, thus using the grapes own sugars for the extra sweetness. This results in a very unusual and popular wine that is sweet to the taste yet dry on the aftertaste.
