Deep intense red wine, with bramble berry, cinnamon, cloves and violets on the nose. The palate is rich and full, with delicate, soft well balanced tannins.

about the harvest: Harvesting performed by hand.

in the cellar : Pre-cooling of grapes to around 6 degrees before crushing. Cold soaking performed for two days, with the start of fermentation, followed by the addition of commercial yeast thereafter. Pump overs done three times per day, with a rack and return (Delestage) and pressed at 0° Balling. 14 days extended skin contact after fermentation to obtain richness. Aged in 225L French oak barrels for 12 months.
