in the vineyard :

Sourced from Compagniesdrifts' own vineyards in Stellenbosch, well drained decomposed granite topsoil with clay subsoil.

The Cabernet Sauvignon- Merlot 2014 was vinified from selected fruit from low-yielding mature vineyards. The vines are densely planted on gravelly, low vigour Vilafontes and Dundee soil which has approximately 15 % clay to ensure water availability to the vines roots right through the growing season. Approximately 30% of the bunches were removed at veraison to increase concentration and complexity of the wine.

about the harvest:

Hand picked.

in the cellar :

Fruit was vinified in stainless steel and soft tannin extraction. Aged in seasoned French oak casks for 12 months before bottling
