**in the vineyard :** Climate: Mediterranean rainfall  $\hat{A}$  650mm per annum.

Soil: A diverse composition of soil and topography add complexity and an array of different characteristics to the wine.

**in the cellar :** This wine is blended with young wine to enhance the fresh fruit flavours very evident in this wine. Aged for 6 months in 225L American oak barrels.
