This dry, fruity wine made from grapes sourced from cooler areas, shows flavours of sunny South Africa. The wine has typical characters of gooseberry, asparagus and tropical flavours and a mouth filling finish. This wine is stunning on its own or with seafood and even goats' cheeses.
