

Manual harvesting of grapes Yield: 8tons/hectare

## in the cellar :

Fermentation occurred in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature ( $25^{\circ}$  -  $28^{\circ}$  C) with two daily pump-overs extracting color and tannins. After natural malolactic fermentation completed the wine matured 14 months in French and American oak barrels.
