in the vineyard : Climate: Mediterranean - Wonderful cool breezes coming from the Indian Ocean as well as the Atlantic Ocean. With an average rainfall of 1100 mm per annum. Although the weather this year was much cooler compared to last year.

Soil Type: Glenrosa soil with good water retention and Longkloof mainly on the lower and middle areas. The shallow shale ground is often rich in salt

in the cellar : The Estate's objective is to use the very best red cultivars of a particular vintage for the Gouverneurs Reserve. New 300 litre medium toasted, tight grained French Oak barrels. Matured for 18 months.
