Generous on the palate, this Reserve wine has a splendid mouthfeel, a weighty luscious palate where exotic passion fruit, peach and gooseberry flavours are in perfect balance. The wine has ripe, sweet unoaked fruit with a flinty edge and yet an elegant, dry finish. Perfect companion to seafoods and creamy fish or chicken dishes, mushroom, asparagus or any white dishes.

**in the vineyard :** The fruit for this hugely rewarding Sauvignon Blanc comes from the best terroir and cooler slopes.

**in the cellar :** Only 20 000 litres of varietal purity enhanced by reductive, minimalistic winemaking were produced. A low fruit yield (averaging five tons per hectare) is the guarantee of a wine ranging in flavour from grass to asparagus and tropical fruit, full of herbaceous fragrance, gooseberry and tropical tones.
