

Val du Charron Reserve Chardonnay 2015

Bright straw hue, intense lemon nose, with apple, cashew, oak, earthy, flinty, and buttery aromas also present. Prominent earthy but underlying grapefruit and oak flavours. Lively. Velvety body, with a crisp and lingering finish. Round and creamy mouthfeel.
