The colour is a youthful, opaque dark crimson. This intense wine is packed with juicy, concentrated fruit and crushed black pepper and finished off with a swirl of sweet vanilla oak. Broad, ripe tannins add support and allow for early accessibility. The wine has great finesse and ends on a high, flavourful peppery note.

**ageing :** Enjoy within 4/5 years.

**in the vineyard :** Pieter believes that Shiraz will do extremely well on Kloovenburg, because of the terrior of the farm. That's why he claimed that "this is Shiraz country".

**about the harvest:** The grapes were harvested in February, the residual sugar averaged 26.2° Balling.

**in the cellar :** The wine was aged for 13 months in first fill French Oak barrels.
