

Kleinbosch Chenin Blanc 2001

Bright and clear, with a light straw colour. Pleasant fruit flavours, typically tropical - the nature of the steen grape. Dry and fresh, crisp and fruity, with a lingering aftertaste.

ageing : The wine is bursting with up-front fruit. Optimum within 18 months from vintage, but would last 24 months.

in the cellar : After being pressed and fermented until dry, the wine is filtered and stabilised. The result is a dry wine, dominated by fruit flavours, with pertinent guava aromas shining through.
