

Rhebokskloof Black Marble Hill Reserve Syrah 2013

With stewed black fruit, aromatic spice and integrated oak characters, this wine confidently reflects elegant and generous Shiraz styling. Smooth-textured with freshness still evident, the juicy palate allows for immediate enjoyment, yet with further ageing potential if cellared perfectly.
