

Waterford Kevin Arnold Shiraz 2014

Vibrant red fruit, earthy and cold stone lead the aromatics of this Stellenbosch Shiraz, accompanied by soft plum fruit and leather spice undertones.

Natural acidity and the classic granular tannins are very characteristic to the nature of a this Stellenbosch Shiraz.

Wines show slight warmth, whites show hints oiliness and richness, reds very classical in style, good aromatics and lovely soft textured palates.

in the vineyard: Good long winter, but late rains and cold delaying pruning. Great windless conditions experienced for flowering resulted in a high yield vintage.

about the harvest: February temperatures were extremely hot pushing ripening and this made for a quick harvest.

in the cellar: Bottling Date: December 2012

Yeast: L2225, L2056

Fermentation: Stainless steel fermented

Barrel ageing: 225Ltr French barrels, 26 months, 4rd and 5th fill and older

Fining: None

Filtration: Bulk filtration prior to bottling
