

Lushof Sauvignon Blanc 2001

An un-wooded, medium bodied wine with obvious Sauvignon Blanc characteristics. Fresher tasting, weightier at 14% alcohol and a brighter fruit intensity than the 2000 vintage. Racy/feline wild shrub ($\hat{a} \in \text{ceperdepisbos} \hat{a} \in \text{ceperdepisbos} \hat{a}$) sniffs for the olfactively adventurous. (quoted from the 2002 John Platters)
