### about the harvest:

Manual harvesting of grapes.

Yield: 8 tons/ hectare

**in the cellar :** Fermentation occurred in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature (25° - 28° C) with two daily pump-overs and punch downs, extracting color and tannins. After natural malolactic fermentation completed the wine matured 14 months in French and American oak barrels.
