

Waverley Hills Shiraz 2017

Intense purple centre with burgundy red rim. Violets and sweet prunes aromas are rounded off by fresh red spices. Subtle aromas of Cape Fynbos and rosemary also come through on the nose. On the palate, the wine has a elegant tannins and a dry finish with spicy and oaky tones.

Very adaptable, the wine can be enjoyed at a light lunch or compliment a hearty lunch or dinner.

in the vineyard : Oak leaf soils, with drip irrigation delivering a production of 8 tons/ha.

in the cellar : Fermented at 24°C in stainless steel, transferred to barrels after malolactic fermentation. After bottling, the wine had 6 months maturation before release.
