Deep red plum colour with a earthy, leathery, spicy upfront nose. Rich plum, blackcurrant and dark chocolate on the mid palate. Bold tannin structure. Long finish with a spicy aftertaste.

in the cellar : The wine was matured for 12 months in French Oak Barrels.
