Some of the best Chenin Blancs find their origins in the Stellenbosch region. Being cooler, the region gives the wine body and fruit intensity. The nose of the wine is pure fruit flavours with a refreshing finish.

about the harvest: The origin of these grapes stems from the Stellenbosch region. Harvesting took place by hand at 22.5°balling in the cool of the morning.

in the cellar: Without crushing or destemming, three hour long pressing took place, followed by fermentation for three weeks in stainless steel tanks. The wine was racked and allowed to age for a few months on the fine lees, whereafter light filtration preceded bottling.



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
