Deep core with fading rim. Dark, ripe, cherry fruit on the nose with bramble notes and fresh floral backing. Gorgeous mouth with deep, ripe berry flavours. Gentle oak with supple and subtle tannins. Easy flow across the palate with lots of ripe berry fruit flavours. Well balanced and easy drinking now yet good development potential.
