

Haute Cabrière Chardonnay Pinot Noir 2018

An unwooded Chardonnay blend, rounded off with Pinot Noir. As per tradition blend for sparkling wines, Chardonnay contribute freshness and finesse to the blend while the Pinot Noir provides body and structure. Expect citrus fruit underline by a firm acidity. An abundance of white peach, citrus, lychee and red fruit on the nose with a delectable mouthfeel.

A good food wine which pairs especially well with Mediterranean dishes.
