Crafted in a vibrant, fruit driven style, Grande Provence Sauvignon Blanc 2018 captures the full tropical fruit spectrum with hints of cut grass on the nose so typical of this variety.

This medium-bodied wine shows an abundance of gooseberries, fig and guava. The palate is concentrated with a zesty acidity and long lingering finish.

Enjoy with vegetarian dishes, salads or lightly seasoned seafood or chicken dishes. This is a lovely food wine, but can also be enjoyed on its own.
