Dark ruby red. Aromas of sweet plums and dark fruit with subtle dark chocolate spicy notes. A medium-bodied wine with attractive up-front fruit flavours and a soft, silky tannins.

Delicious with oxtail, casseroles, red meat, game, pizza and pasta dishes.

in the vineyard : The grapes were sourced from vineyards across the Western Cape. The viticulturist works hand-in-hand with the grape growers in managing each vineyard block to ensure the best quality fruit for this wine. The different microclimates and soil types associated with each vineyard add to the complexity of the wine.

in the cellar :

The grapes were harvested by hand and machine at 23° to 25° Balling during February and March. The fruit was crushed and fermented on the skins in temperature-controlled stainless-steel tanks at 25°C to 28°C for 10 to 14 days. The wine was matured in contact with French and American oak for a period of four months.
