**in the vineyard :** Situated on the cool side of Paarl Mountain, with Table Mountain visible, it will be easy for our consumers to observe all the cultivar fruit exceptions within our wines.

**about the harvest:** These healthy grapes from the cultivars Chenin Blanc and Chardonnay were hand harvested and fermented separately.

**in the cellar :** Directly after alcohol fermentation this blend of Chenin Blanc 51% and 49% Chardonnay was made.
