

ageing: To be enjoyed within the next 12 months.

in the vineyard: Situated on the cool side of Paarl Mountain, with Table Mountain visible, it will be easy for our consumers to observe all the cultivar fruit exceptions within our wines.

about the harvest: These healthy grapes from the cultivars Chenin Blanc and Chardonnay were hand harvested and fermented separately.

in the cellar: Directly after alcohol fermentation this blend of Chenin Blanc 51% and 49% Chardonnay was made.
