

Haute Cabrière Pinot Noir Reserve 2016

Expect forest floor and red berries on the nose, typical to the Pinot Noir varietal. In addition to that, one can also expect fine hints of truffle on the nose and palate, complimented by notes of tobacco, cedar and spice. Matured for 11 months in 228L Burgundy Oak Barrels.

Serve slightly chilled at 16 degree Celsius. This wine pairs well with rare meat dishes like steak tartare, as well as venison dishes like Springbok lion.
