Subtle flavours of pink candy-floss, fresh strawberry and rich cream are carried through from nose to palate. A gentle balance between fruit and well integrated acidity yields an elegant, restrained and feminine wine.

Enjoy chilled with cheese, cold meats, poultry and pasta; or just solo.

in the vineyard : The fruit is from both younger vines, that drive the fruit profile, and low-yielding older vineyards, that provide a very finely structured backbone. Oak leaf and weathered granite soils ensure these vines are planted in soils rich in organic matter.

in the cellar : A variety of Backsberg's premium red cultivars are blended together to create a soft, easy-drinking red wine. This wine incorporates portions of exceptional wines of various winemaking styles with some high-quality oak aged components building a beautiful backbone for this value-for-money blend.
