Deep purple, violet. Nose - intense fruit with overriding plum spice with toasty wood tones. Palate - Big well balanced palate of red berry fruits, spice and plums finishing with a ripe tannin balance and subtle wooding. The wine was matured in 75% French oak, 25% American and of the total 28% was new.

**about the harvest:** The grapes from low yielding vineyards, picked at optimum ripeness.

**in the cellar :** The pulp was fermented in open tanks with regular punch downs to create a well structured wine with ripe tannins. The wine was matured in 75% French oak, 25% American and of the total 28% was new.
