

Leopards Leap Lookout Semi-Sweet 2019

Aromas of peach and pear, gentle tropical fruit and sweet lemon intertwined with subtle floral notes. The nose follows through on the palate with delicate apple blossom flavours and subtle citrus notes. The sugar-sweet character of this wine is beautifully balanced by the natural acidity, creating a vibrant burst of zestiness in the after-taste.

Tastes like candied fruit and orange peel. Enjoy with interesting conversation and spicy food, anytime of day!
