

Bouchard Finlayson Galpin Peak Pinot Noir Tete de Cuvee 1999

Pinot Noir has often been quoted as an exasperating variety for growers, winemakers and wine drinkers alike. It is sometimes said to be feminine, alluring or capricious but most of all it is that tantalizing desire to achieve richness with this grape which forces perseverance and ultimately satisfies the Holy Grail of wine making. It is by comparison to the 1997 Tete de Cuvee a finer wine with classic subtlety, reflecting an aristocratic structure.
