

Jan Harmsgat Pinot Noir 2019

Our JHG Pinot Noir is light in colour and bursting in fruit flavours, fresh and light in style but elegant red wine. Notes of cherries and strawberries, with a soft and silky texture finish on the palate.

Style: Light and soft in style red wine

Nose: Dark cherries and strawberries, slight earthiness

Palate: Soft tannin structure and smooth texture

Wine can be enjoyed slightly chilled.

Since 1723, Jan Harmsgat Farm, or JHG, is situated on the most southern tip of the Robertson Wine valley along the foothills of the Langerberg Mountains.

Our newest addition to the JHG boutique wine collection is the Pinot Noir. The very first attempt at making this wine we won the trophy for best Pinot Noir in the Robertson Wine Valley at the Young Wine Awards.

in the vineyard : Our unique position borders with the dry conditions of the Karoo as well as the cool sea breezes from the Coastal Regions. The direction of planting runs from east to west.

Highlighting our vineyard's unique characteristics, maturation takes place in neutral vessels. We invite wine lovers world-wide to taste the beauty of our valley.

in the cellar : Wood maturation: 3 months, 225L French oak, 4th fill.
